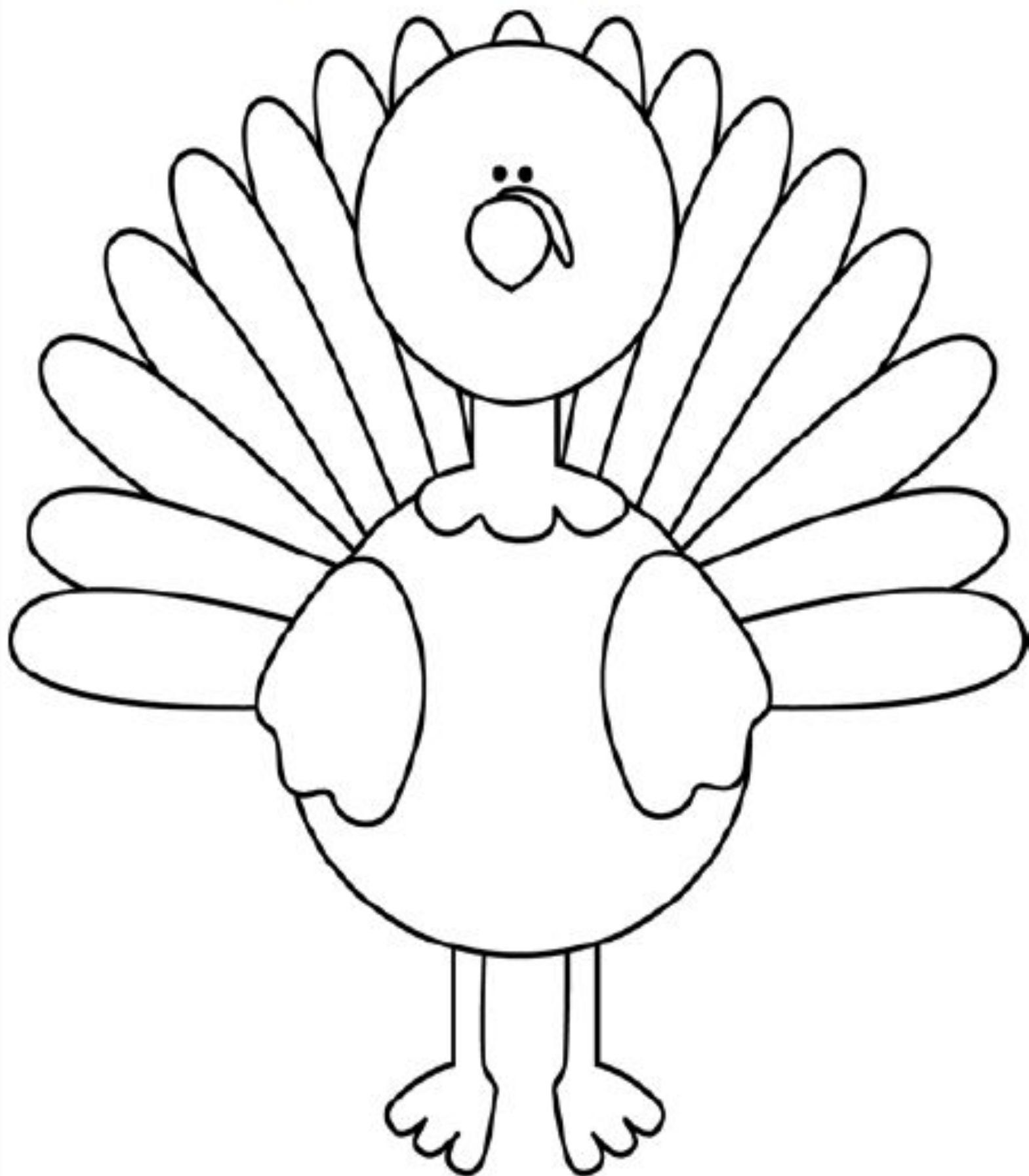


# DISGUISE OUR TURKEY
